> Flight 93 National Memorial Hours Change New Hours; Sunrise to Sunset as of October 19,2015

Shanksville, PA – Beginning Monday, October 19, 2015 Flight 93 National Memorial will be open from sunrise to sunset. Superintendent Stephen M. Clark encourages visitors to plan to visit the Memorial between dawn and dusk, and for their own safety all visitors must exit the Memorial before sunset. The Memorial is closed from sunset to sunrise. Entrance to the Memorial is free, no entrance fees are charged.

The recently opened Flight 93 National Memorial Visitor Center hours will continue to be from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tickets will be distributed at the visitor center for individual entry through October 31. Anyone who has made a reservation online should check in at the Visitor Center to pick up their reserved tickets. Beginning November 1, only groups of 15 or more will need to make reservations online at <u>recreation.gov</u> to tour the visitor center. Individual entry will be on a first-come, first-served basis. During periods of heavy visitation, expect to wait outside in lines for entry.
